

BARC ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE

SELF-GENERATED LOAD RIDER

1. APPLICABILITY

Applicable upon request to consumers purchasing competitive generation and transmission service from the Cooperative under Schedule LP and having a monthly demand load of 500 kW or more, who have customer-owned generation which can be operated during unspecified hours of any month to reduce the consumers demand.

2. MONTHLY GENERATION CAPACITY CREDIT

\$5.04 per kW generated by the Consumer during the same 60-minute period in which the Old Dominion Monthly Delivered Demand is determined pursuant to the Interconnection and Operation Agreement between ODEC and Virginia Power (CP). This 60-minute period represents the clock hour in each calendar month during which the combined system (Virginia Power and ODEC) peak demand occurs. Capacity credits shall be limited to the applicant's billed kW demand in any month.

3. PERIODS OF OPERATION

Recommendations for periods of operation can be obtained by the Cooperative's Load Management System, telephone, or other appropriate means.

The period of operation shall begin at the designated clock hour which has been recommended and at which the Consumer decides to generate, or at a mutually agreed upon time.

The period of operation shall end fifteen minutes after the last generation period, or at a mutually agreed upon time.

It is always the responsibility of the Consumer to operate customer-owned generation equipment and the Cooperative is not responsible for failure of the Consumer to operate its generation during the CP for any reason.

4. PARALLEL OPERATION

The Consumer may operate consumer-owned generation in parallel with the Cooperative's distribution system provided the Consumer enters into a "Generation Intertie and Parallel Operation Agreement" with the Cooperative.
