COMMERCIAL AND SMALL POWER SERVICE SCHEDULE B

1. AVAILABILITY

Available throughout Cooperative's service territory subject to the Cooperative's Terms and Conditions of Service.

2. APPLICABILITY

Applicable members of the Cooperative including commercial consumers, small industrial consumers, governmental entities, public use facilities, and non-profit groups with loads under 50 kW, and for energy which is to be resold.

Schedule B shall apply to any connection not qualifying for service under Schedule A or Schedule LP.

Consumers having their homes on the same premises with their business establishments may include service to both on the same meter, in which case all service will be billed under this schedule, using the rates set out below. A consumer may make provision for two meters, in which case usage for residential purposes will be billed under the appropriate residential rate and usage for business purposes will be billed under this schedule and rate.

3. TYPE OF SERVICE

Single-phase and three-phase where available, at available voltages.

Note: The above Distribution Charges and Electricity Supply Service Charges apply to those Consumers who have the Cooperative as their energy service provider. Only the Distribution Charges apply to those Consumers who have an Electricity Supplier other than the Cooperative as their energy provider.

5. POWER COST ADJUSTMENT CLAUSE

Each kilowatt-hour purchased by the Customer from the Cooperative under the Monthly Rate is subject to adjustment in accordance with the Cooperative's Power Cost Adjustment, Schedule PCA.

6. MINIMUM MONTHLY DISTRIBUTION DELIVERY CHARGE

The minimum monthly distribution delivery charge for service under this rate shall be the applicable Consumer Delivery Charge where a 15 kVA or less of transformer capacity is required. For members requiring more than 15 kVA of transformer capacity, the minimum monthly distribution delivery charge shall be increased at the rate of 55¢ for each additional kVA or fraction thereof required.

7. AVOIDED CONSUMER DELIVERY CHARGE

Customers who request discontinuance of service and who subsequently request that service be resumed at the same address will be assessed an Avoided Consumer Delivery Charge equal to: (1) the number of months during which service is disconnected times the Consumer Delivery Charge and (2) other applicable service charges according to the terms and conditions. The Avoided Consumer Delivery Charge described in (1) shall be applied when reconnection is requested within 365 days of disconnection, and shall not be applied when the disconnection resulted directly from an act or acts of God beyond the customer's control, including, but not limited to, severe wind, flood, or fire.
